

## Taiwan Healthcare Students' Declaration On The Implementation of The United Nations Sustainable Development Goals

*Aware that* the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, with 17 goals and 169 targets, were launched as the mutual aims of global society;

*Also aware of* the needs of a cooperative strategy on the development of international affairs and domestic campaigns for all Taiwan healthcare students;

*Bearing in mind* that the future leaders are expected to take innovative actions as Taiwan is aiming at fulfillment of United Nations Sustainable Development Goals;

Thus we declare the following,

1. All healthcare students shall realise that the basis of sustainable development is “human being,” and be dedicated to promote interdisciplinary engagement fields to reach sustainable as well as inclusive economic growth, social development, and environmental protection.
2. All healthcare students shall join the civil actions of different fields with possession of their professions and humanistic literacies.
3. The youth, as future leaders, shall be devoted in Meaningful Youth Participations at local, national, regional, and international scales.

4. Healthcare students shall arouse public awareness on food security via public health issues to ensure the nutrition needs are accomplished, especially for those in poverty.
5. Healthcare students shall involve themselves in the process of reform on National Health Insurance in pursuit of a sustainable public service on health coverage.
6. Healthcare students shall help reach health at all ages via actively spreading to the public relevant knowledges and values.
7. Healthcare students shall improve their clinical as well as research skills on the preparations toward emerging infectious diseases and public health emergencies brought about by climate change, extreme weather events, and natural disasters.
8. Healthcare students shall work on eradication of discriminations toward reproductive diseases and LGBTQIA+ population by encouragement to open discussions on reproductive health and gender equality.
9. All healthcare students shall join hands with the youth of different professions for the realisation of One Health, cooperate or scrutinise the governmental policies on water and air quality, and adhere to sustainability and environmental justice.
10. Healthcare students shall shoulder the social responsibilities to ensure that “Health in all policies” is adopted in the aspects of political, economical, legal, household, health and welfare, technology innovation, and social justice.

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
